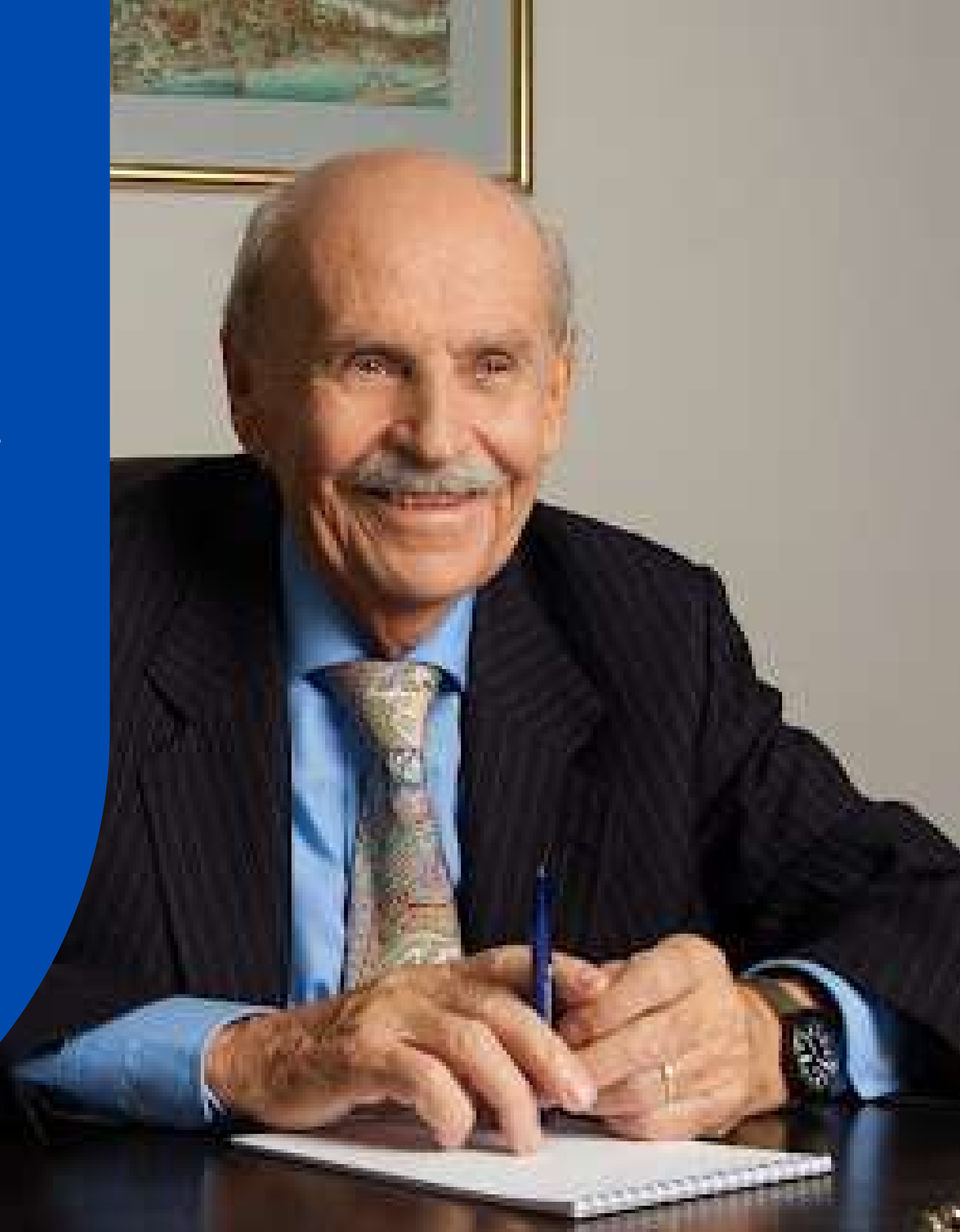
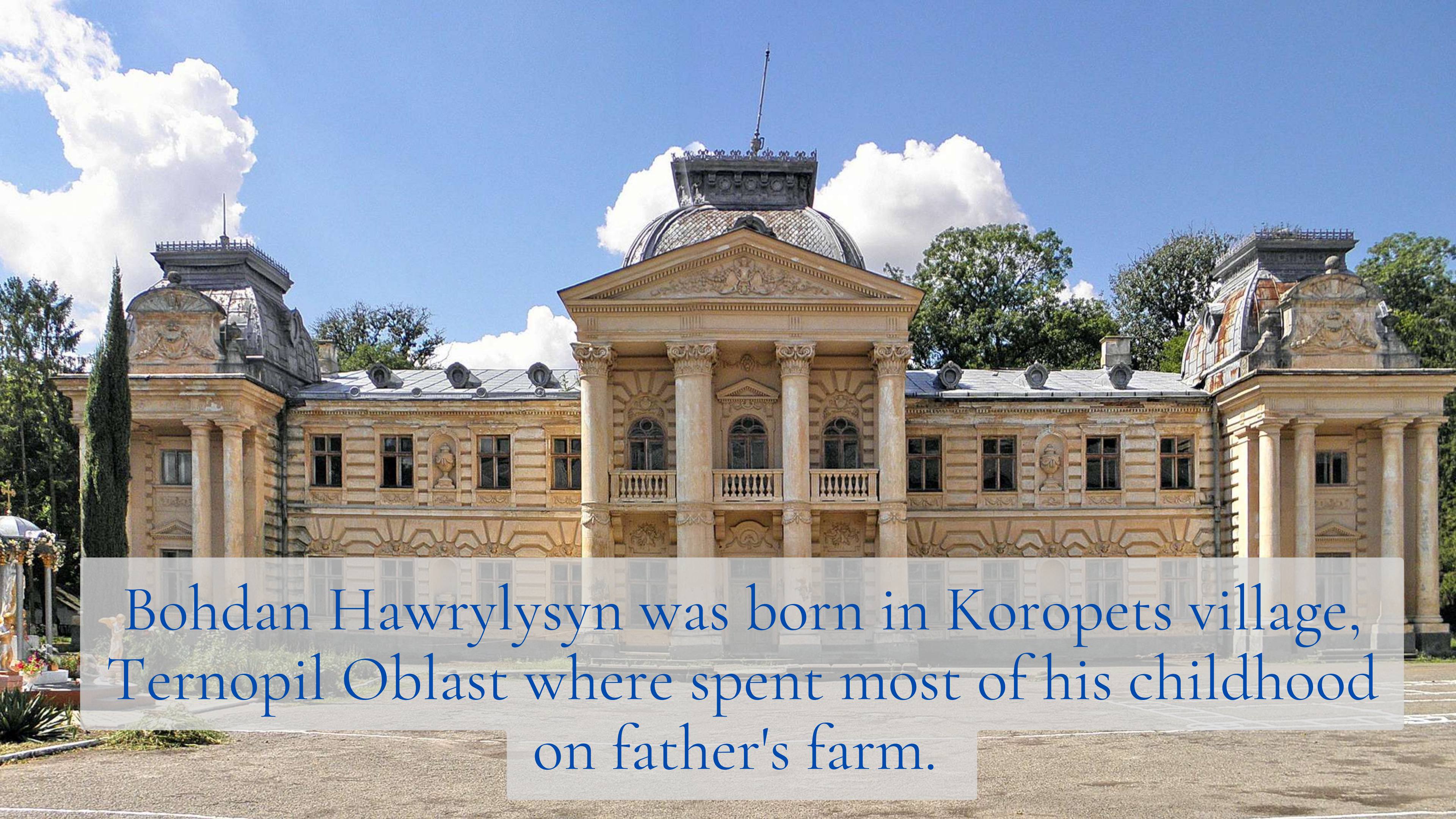


BOHDAN HAVRYLISHYN.

Bohdan Hawrylysyn was born in Koropets village, Ternopil Oblast where spent most of his childhood on father's farm.

During World War II in 1944, he was captured by the Nazis and displaced to Germany. After the war, he spent almost two years in a displaced persons camp, and afterwards moved to Canada as a lumberjack. While working at various jobs Hawrylyshyn was admitted at the University of Toronto.

In 1968 Bohdan Hawrylyshyn became the Director of the institute and remained its head for eighteen years. During this time at the Institute, Bohdan Hawrylyshyn brought up a great number of top professionals for hundreds of companies all over the world.

Bohdan Havrylyshyn had a Canadian passport and was a resident of Switzerland, but he always said that he was Ukrainian.





Bohdan Havrylyshyn lived with his beloved wife Leni (Leonida Petrovna) for 65 years. The couple had three children.

After 1991, Havrylyshyn became an adviser to the first president of Ukraine, four speakers of the Verkhovna Rada and three prime ministers. He took an active part in the creation of an international charity fund in Ukraine.

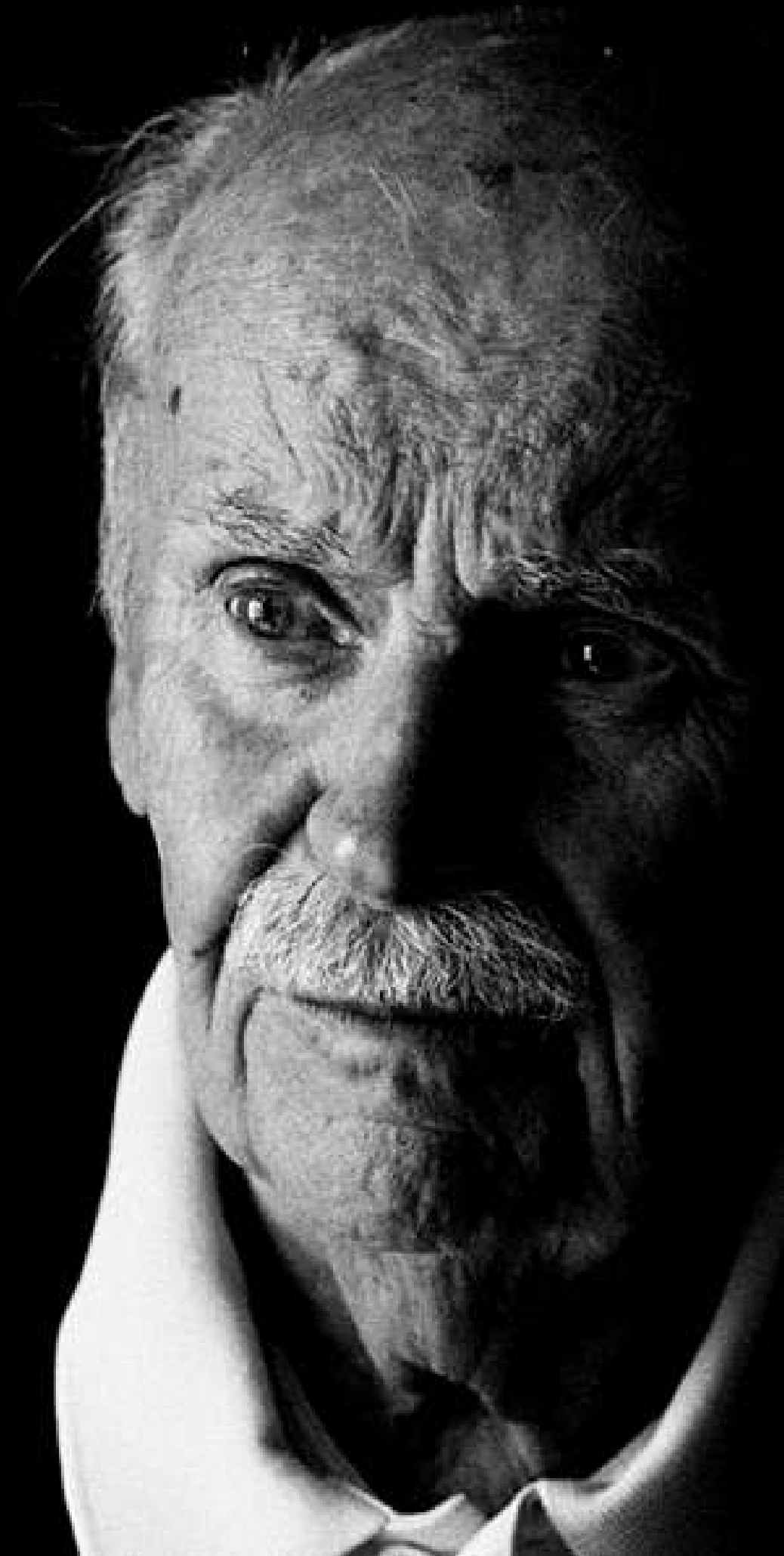


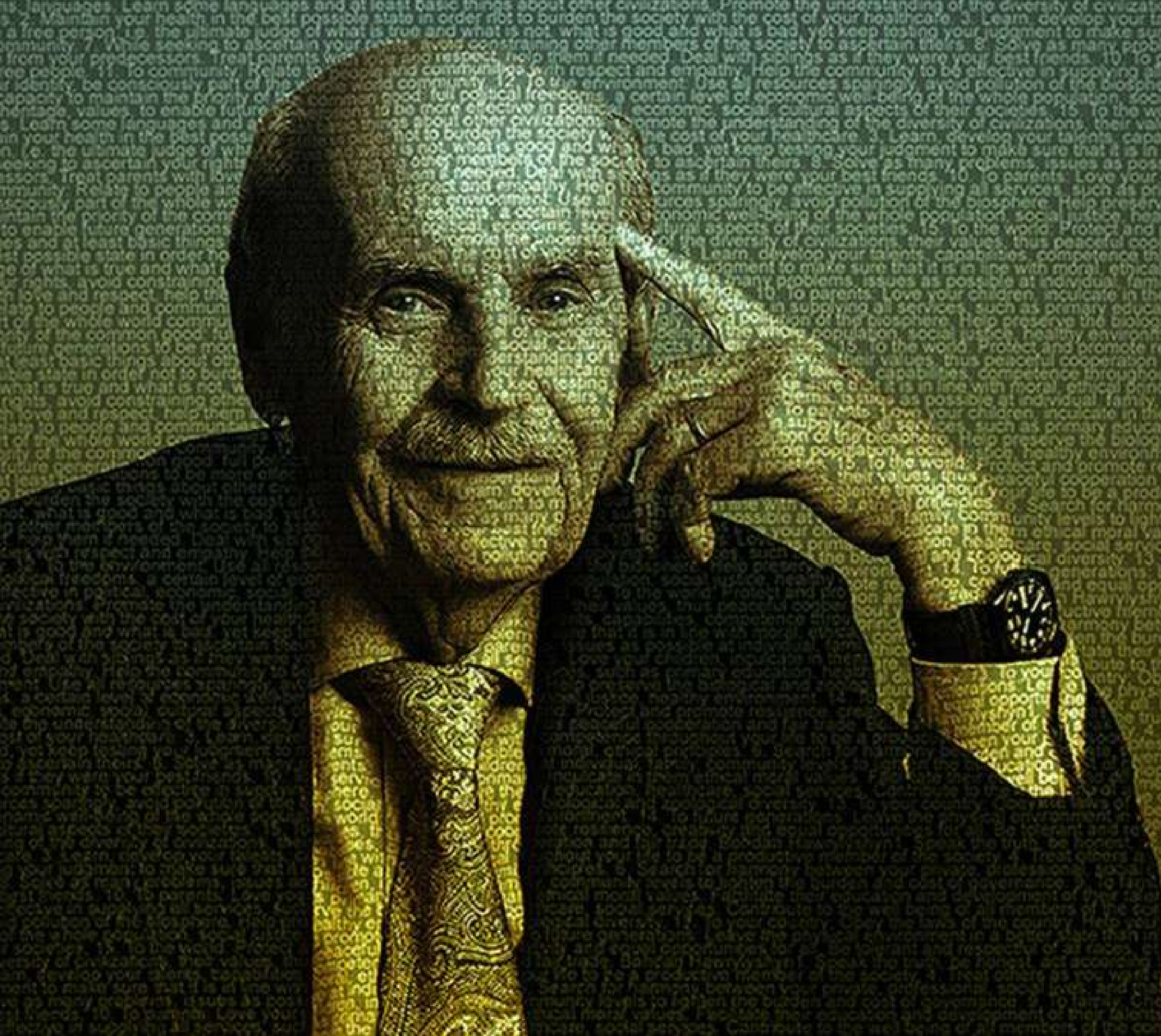
14. Enable future generations to be more effective in political, economic, social, cultural aspects of their societies
